Westlake gets Gold Scenic City Certification

WESTLAKE The Scenic City Certification Program of Scenic Texas has given Westlake the Gold Scenic City Certification.

Westlake was Gold certified in 2010 and has recently been re-certified Gold, the second-highest level. The certification lasts five years.

“We are appreciative of this recognition,” said Westlake Town Manager Tom Brymer. “Westlake has worked hard to develop strong aesthetic standards that reflect the unique, natural beauty of our community.”

According to the program’s website, Westlake’s scenic strong points include having all utilities underground and a preservation policy for the natural knolls in town.

The town joins other Northeast Tarrant cities Colleyville, Grapevine, Keller, Roanoke and Trophy Club as other certified scenic cities, ranging from Platinum to Bronze levels.

The Scenic City Certification Program was created because a community’s economic development is linked to its visual appearance, the organization’s website says. It “recognizes Texas municipalities that implement high-quality scenic standards for public roadways and spaces.”
