

## **Board of Aldermen accepting applications for boards, commissions, and committees.**

### **4B Economic Development Board**

(Two positions - expiring terms of June 2009)

Since 4B revenues are already obligated, the board meets no more than one time per year to review expenditures.

The purpose of the Corporation is to promote economic development within the City and State of Texas in order to eliminate unemployment and underemployment, and to promote and encourage employment and the public welfare of, for, and on behalf of the Town by developing, implementing financing, and providing one or more projects for any of the following purposes: professional and amateur sports and athletics, tourist, entertainment, convention and public park purposes, including but limited to, stadiums, ball parks, auditoriums, amphitheatres, concert halls, parks and park facilities, municipal buildings, museums, exhibition facilities, and related equipment and facilities, utilities, roads, and other related facilities as defined and permitted under Section 4B of the Act.

### **Historical Preservation Society**

One position - expiring term of June 2009)

Meets the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of each month at 6 p.m.

The Westlake Historical Preservation Board was created to discover, preserve, and perpetuate the history of the Town of Westlake and the Cross Timbers region.

### **Public Art Committee**

(One position - expiring term of June 2010)

#### *Town of Westlake Public Art Committee Mission Statement*

*Founded as a commitment to protect and improve the quality of life of Westlake residents, businesses and students by encouraging, inspiring, documenting, educating and entertaining artistic and creative endeavors throughout the community, the Westlake Public Art committee will provide a wide range of professionally excellent and artistically significant presentations, preserving, collecting, exhibiting, and fostering the engagement of arts into the community.*

The Board of Aldermen established the following scope and priorities for the Public Art Committee:

1. Identify and recommend artists and raise funds to ultimately commission an outdoor statue of The Blacksmith at a designated location at Westlake Academy.
2. Raise funds to be able to acquire and display significant works of art consistent with the theme and culture of the Town of Westlake to display in Westlake Academy and other public buildings.
3. Raise awareness of the importance of the role of art in Westlake by sponsoring artistic and creative endeavors that will benefit the community.

### **Texas Student Housing Board of Directors**

(One position - expiring term of June 2008)

Meets the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month at 5:30 p.m.

The mission of the Texas Student Housing Authority is to provide university housing scholarships to graduates of Texas high schools and community colleges.

The Board of Directors ensures the financial stability of TSHA and oversees the financial transactions thereof. The Board of Directors approves all budgets and audits of the Authority as well as any plans for the future services and operations of the Authority.

### **Westlake Tree City USA Advisory Committee**

(One position - expiring term of June 2008;

One position expiring term of 2009;

Two positions - expiring terms of June 2008)

Meets as needed

The Committee recommends and coordinates the study, investigation, counsel, development and/or updating of the Town Tree Plan and maintain the Town's the Tree City USA designation.

Plans, coordinates, and implements activities, announcements, and media publicity related to the Town's annual observance of Arbor Day.
