TSH SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Accepted by the university, in good standing
- ✓ Academic scholarships* – GPA 3.0, SAT 1650, class standing top 25% (priority point ratings within each category evaluated)
- ✓ Additional considerations – leadership, community service, honors, employment, letters of recommendation, need**
- ✓ Texas community college graduates awarded scholarships without consideration of GPA, SAT or class standing
- ✓ Renewal scholarships – CGPA 3.0 and taking 15 hours per semester
provisional renewals 2.5 CGPA progressing toward 3.0.

* ANY ONE OF THE THREE REQUIREMENTS MAY BE WAIVED TO (VALUE)
