WHERE DO I PARK MY CAR? While Aspen Lane is closed, you may park your car at the Maintenance Building at 2901 Dove Road. No vehicle will be allowed on the newly treated road surfaces until the road is reopened. Please do not park within 50 feet of any road being worked on.

WHAT IF MY CAR IS PARKED ON A ROAD THAT IS CLOSED? **We will begin work at 7:00 A.M. on July 22. Vehicles will be allowed to exit the area up until 9:00 A.M.** The streets being treated will be closed for 24 hours. If your vehicle is on a street that will be blocked by adjacent surfacing work, it will have to remain until the work is complete.

WHAT IF I DRIVE ON THE ROAD WHILE IT'S CLOSED? Please do not attempt to drive on the road while it is closed as this may cause damage to your vehicle and several thousands of dollars of damage to the newly treated surface. Town of Westlake and ANDALE CONSTRUCTION **IS NOT** responsible for damage to your vehicle or to the newly treated road surface.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: How will we get our mail, FEDEX, and UPS packages?

A: We have coordinated with the postal service and you will receive your mail and packages as scheduled.

Q: How will the shuttle system work?

A: You should be able to park at the Maintenance Building at 2901 Dove Rd. If assistance is needed with transport between your home and vehicle, please call Kory Kittrell 817-788-1030 between the hours of 6:00 am and 10:00 pm.

Q: How will this affect any landscaping work?

A: Please hold off on any landscape work while road work is being performed. Turn off sprinkler systems during and 24 hours after the road is treated.

Q: How will this affect emergency vehicles?

A: Emergency vehicles will be able to access any home in the neighborhood 24 hours a day.
